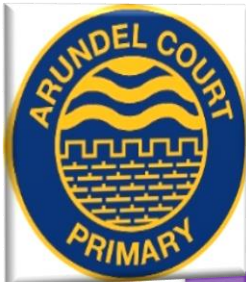

Their writing was well presented, purposeful and fun to read. Keep it up children!



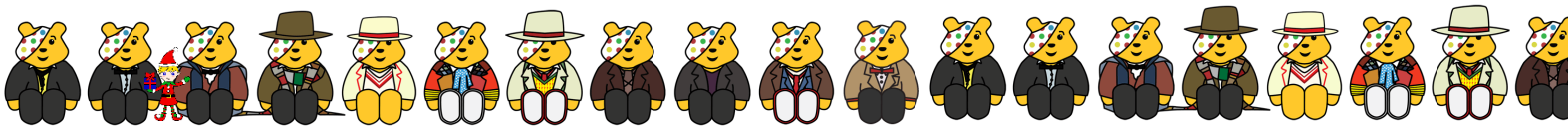
WHO JUST GOT MARRIED?

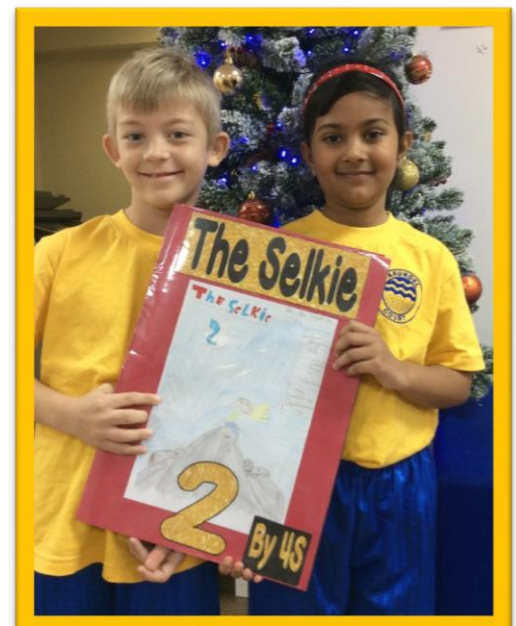

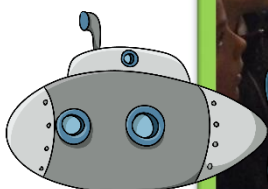
