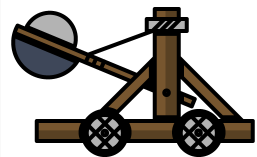
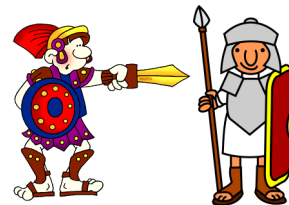

You've heard about the Rotten Romans but now it's time to find out exactly how terrible (but brilliant) they were!

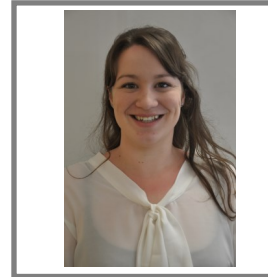

YEAR 3 - THE IMPORTANT STUFF!

HOME READING

In Key Stage 2, the expectation is that all pupils will read at least 3 times per week as part of their **HOMEWORK**. In Year 3, this should be to an adult or an older sibling who can sign their reading record.

Reading Records will be checked
EVERY FRIDAY MORNING.

If your child has read and had their reading record completed and signed at least 3 times in the week, it will be signed off by a member of staff as a **successful week of home reading**.

5 x Successful Home Reading Weeks - a certificate.

10 x Successful Home Reading Weeks - a certificate and special treat.

WEEKLY SPELLINGS

Every Monday, the Year 3 children will be tested on their weekly spellings which will have been provided the week before as part of their **spelling and handwriting HOMEWORK**.

A list of each week's spellings will be sent home at the beginning of each half term and some of these will be personalised for your child.

In order to move onto the next set of spellings, your child will need to get 7 or more out of 10 on their test! This will increase to 8 out of 10 later in the year.

TIMES TABLES

Every Friday, the Year 3 children will complete a timed times table test based on the times tables they are working on. This will be tracked throughout the year and they will be able to earn certificates according to their level.

HOMEWORK - Regular practise of times tables at home using TT Rockstars.

TT ROCKSTARS

TT Rockstars is an engaging and competitive online programme of daily times table practice, through which your child can improve their speed, knowledge and arithmetic in a carefully selected sequence. Each child creates and develops their own avatar and competes against other players, including their classmates in a secure and safe online environment.

PE
