Welcome to Year 4

We look forward to seeing you in September.

Autumn Term - Our topic is A Place Called Home. We will be looking at the invasion of Britain by the Anglo Saxons. We will be studying their way of life and learning about their customs and traditions, many of which are still used today. We will also look at animals and their homes (habitats). Then we will learn about electricity and how it is used in our homes.



Spring Term - Our topic is A Journey Through the Natural World. We will be learning about the natural world. This will include studying mountains, volcanoes and rivers. We will look at the different climate zones across the world and will learn how to use maps. We will also look at different materials and learn about solids, liquids and gasses and explore how these change.



Summer Term - Our topic is Digging into the Past. We will use different ways to find out about the past. Through this topic we will be learning about the Ancient Egyptians. We will consider how we know about the Egyptians and learn about the job of an archaeologist. We will also study how we can keep warm and learn about thermal insulators and conductors.



What do we expect in Year 4?

Reading at home

It is expected that your child reads at home at least 3 times a week to support and develop their fluency and comprehension. We would like this reading to be recorded in your child's reading record book which they will be given.



Spellings

It is a statutory requirement that the children learn certain words throughout each year they are at school and there is a list of words that we will be focussing on. Your child will be learning spelling rules to go alongside this. Spellings will be sent home on Monday and tested again the following Monday.



Maths

We will be working through the Magnificent Multiplication scheme that we have in school. The children have to complete each test 3 times before they can move on to the next one. The tests start on copper and finish on emerald. Children will receive certificates when they achieve this. At home you can support your child by helping them become more fluent at their times tables, this can be done through logging on to TT Rockstars each week.
