


Our topic this half term is 'Man on the Moon'.

We will continue to develop our calculation skills and use our knowledge to build and represent numbers to 50. We will practise counting confidently in 2s and 10s and will be exploring measuring weight and volume. Knowing number facts fluently is extremely important in Year 1 and recalling 1 more/less than numbers to 100 and pairs of numbers to make any number up to 10 will be practised daily. This is something you can work on with your child at home.
