


GDPR

You may be aware that from May, the rules around data protection are changing. The 'General Data Protection Regulation' (GDPR) will change how we can use your personal data and keep it safe, and will also strengthen your rights over your own data.

The point of this is to make sure sensitive or private information about yourselves and your children stays safe. Whilst it is similar to the current Data Protection Act in many ways, there are a few differences, so we need to make a few changes at the school in order to ensure we remain compliant.

As part of our work to comply with the GDPR, we are also re-seeking consent for using photographs or videos of your child on our website, internal displays or other school materials/other consent request.

We will be sending a permission form, and would appreciate it if you filled this out and returned it to the school office ASAP.

SCHOOL HOLIDAY IN TERM TIME

Holidays in term time will **NOT** be authorised. Exceptional circumstances may be considered by the Headteacher. 'Exceptional' means unavoidable circumstances. Please note that there are 175 days within a school year for families to take a holiday.

The children will be starting back *Thursday the 6th of September*, in the new school year, which may give you a chance to pay a little less for your holiday.

85% attendance means they have missed 6 weeks of school, which is a whole half term!

For strict health and safety reasons their feet need to be covered up.


TRI GOLF FESTIVAL

NEW SCHOOL BUILD UPDATE

The agreed dates so far are:

1. The hoarding (fencing) will be erected on the school field from 7th January 2019 and building begins.
2. The school building should be completed by 1st November 2019 and we move into the new school over the course of a week.
3. The old school will be demolished and the area made good taking approximately 34 weeks.
4. The school and new school field and playgrounds ready by 10th July 2020.

DREAMFLIGHT CAKE SALE



Dreamflight is a registered UK charity that changes young lives through taking children with a serious illness or disability on a holiday of a lifetime to Orlando Florida.

Once a year 192 deserving children from all over the UK, accompanied by a team of medical carers, board a chartered British Airways flight and head to Florida to spend 10 magical days of fun and excitement. Many of the children could not undertake such a trip without the support of the army of doctors, nurses, physiotherapists and non-medical volunteers who care for the children 24 hours a day. To give you an idea the cost per child is on average £3500 for them to have this amazing once in a lifetime experience.

Dreamflight is not just a holiday, it does something that medicine can't. The children leave their families behind giving them the opportunity to discover independence, confidence and a whole new outlook on life. Often for the first time, these children realise that they are not alone, and they are not the odd one out.

I am planning a cake sale on Thursday 7th June after school (outside the library) to raise money for this amazing cause. Please pop along and buy a cake or two to help make a difference, your support would be very much appreciated.

Also on the 10th of June I am part of a team of 36 (30 swimmers/6 support) British Airways Cabin Crew and Pilots that are taking on the challenge of swimming the 1.5 miles from Alcatraz to San Francisco Bay. The water is notoriously very cold with strong currents and the possibility of sharks!! This event is also to raise money for Dreamflight.
