Year 4 suggested Daily Timetable



<p>9.00 – 9.30am</p> 	<p>Reading for Pleasure There are so many different things you could read for example a book, a magazine, a comic or an article on the internet to name just a few! It may also be an opportunity to listen to someone else reading. This could be an e-book (through your library login), a sibling or parent. Or you reading to someone else in your home even your favourite teddy! The reading possibilities are endless – what a lovely start to the day!</p>
<p>9.35 – 9.50am</p> 	<p>Morning Register in Class Teams (found on 4AW, 4TS and 4CM channel on Teams)</p>
<p>10.00 – 11.00am</p> 	<p>English including Spelling (found on the English channel on Teams) The sessions will follow the normal structure of an 'in school' lesson: Spelling will be a 15-20mins section of this lesson. You will need to watch the video input from the teacher then complete the short activity. English this will be a 40-45mins lesson. You will need to watch the video input from the teacher then complete the activity set.</p>
<p>11.00 – 11.15am</p> 	<p>Break Grab yourself a drink and a healthy snack!</p>
<p>11.15am – 12.15pm</p> 	<p>Maths (found on the Maths channel on Teams) The sessions will follow the normal structure of an 'in school' maths lesson. The maths video will begin with a Rapid Recall activity which should take you 10-15 minutes. Then you can return to the video to watch the teacher's input for the main activity. Followed by a task to complete and a challenge.</p>
<p>12.15pm – 1.15pm</p> 	<p>Lunch It is important that you fuel your mind and body, so enjoy a well-earned lunch break. If you can get outside and get a bit of fresh air.</p>
<p>1.15pm – 1.35pm</p> 	<p>Handwriting (found on the Handwriting channel) During this time, you are using Computers, Laptops and Devices for some of your work however it is important that we also focus on our handwriting. There will be an activity on Teams for you to complete such as copying spelling words or a poem. Remember to look carefully at the ascenders and descenders.</p>
<p>1.40pm – 1.50pm</p> 	<p>Afternoon Register in Class Teams (found on 4AW, 4TS and 4CM channel on Teams) and class story.</p>
<p>2.00pm – 3.00pm</p> 	<p>Topic (found on the Topic channel on Teams) Each day there will be a different activity / subject such as Geography, Science, Art, P.E) There will be a teacher video input followed by an activity to complete during this hour session.</p>
<p>3.00pm – 3.20pm</p> 	<p>Times Table Practise By the end of Year 4, all children are expected to know their times tables up to 12 x 12. So this short daily burst of practising is really important. There are so many fun ways to learn them such as TT Rockstars and Hit the Button or chanting them and writing them out.</p>
<p>This is a suggested timetable to help you structure the day. However, we are aware that many families are sharing devices to complete the remote learning so do not feel that you have to stick to the times stipulated if they do not work for you and your family. The activities can be completed at different times throughout the day.</p> <p>Year 4 teachers will be available to respond to any work related questions between 9am-3pm, Monday – Friday on the relevant channels. So for example, if it is a question about the Maths, please post on the Maths chat page. This is purely for teacher and child interaction about the work that has been set.</p>
