In 1969, the USA launched the Saturn V rocket. It was the biggest rocket ever. There were three astronauts on the 👖 rocket called Neil Annstrong, Buzz Aldrin and Michael Collins. It took 4 days to get to the moon. The Eagle Lunar Module landed on the 😹 moon. Nei Armstrong was the first man to step onto the moon. He said ' that's one small step for man; one giant leap for mankind." Buzz Aldrin was next. They collected rocks and moon dirt and left a flag there.
